



CBMC Golf Event Advice

First, you need to recruit 6-7 faithful men to be on the committee. This requires a committee member to meet face-to-face with each member of the team to align on the evangelism focus of the tournament. Then, those committee members would have a face-to-face with the prospective team captains.

There are a few principles we strive to follow:

- Provide free registration to pre-Christian golfers
- Vetting the guest speaker who will be giving testimony and the invitation to Christ – this helps to ensure he understands the audience he is speaking to
- Focus on reaching the lost and not fundraising
- Golf committee and team captains meet the night before the event to pray over the event, speaker, players, and weather

We believe a first-class event contains the following criteria and this is what we strive for:

- 20 - 22 teams with a team captain (max of 4 players on each team)
- Reputable golf course in the area
- Great lunch provided
- Name brand golf shirt (if budget allows)
- Goodie bag (if sponsors are available to provide funding)
- Free on course beverages & snacks (donated)
- Goal: 4-hour round of golf (No on-course golf gimmicks) – “Par is your friend”
- Closest to the pin prizes (if donated or budget allows)
- Awards after the tournament with heavy hors d’oeuvres
- Winners do not need to be present to claim prizes
- Time – 11:00 lunch, 11:20 testimony, 12:00 golf, 4:30 finished
